


JOURNEY YARA VALLEY, VIC

Founded by ex Tetsuya's and Pier Sommelier
Damian North, whose move to winemaking
culminated in five years as the head winemaker at
the famous Leeuwin Estate before settling in the
Yarra to establish Journey. The winery's current
stewards continue the work of making fine, detailed,
Pinots and Chardonnays from their great terroirs in
the Yarra Valley including the Tribute vineyard and
the Willow Lake vineyard.

BARRINGWOOD TASMANIA

Barringwood's story began in 1993, when the first vines were planted on the site of a former sawmill in Lower Barrington, Tasmania. Over the years, Barringwood has grown from a small vineyard into one of Tasmania's most admired wine producers, with additional vineyard plantings in Cranbrook and Evandale, and 33 hectares of vines established by 2016 across the three sites. The estate has consistently maintained a 5-star rating from James Halliday's Wine Companion, earning critical acclaim for its elegance, precision and sense of place. Grapes are farmed and made in consultation with Tasmanian wine icons Jeremy Dineen and Peter Dredge.


CRANEFORD BAROSSA VALLEY, SA

Founded in 1978, Craneford Wines has an established reputation for producing top-quality wines rooted in the diverse terroirs of the Barossa Valley. The winery is housed in the historic Country Fire Station building in Truro, a small town on the northern edge of the Barossa, which serves as the insipration for their signature wine, the 'Fire Station Shiraz'. Craneford sources grapes from select vineyards farmed organically and biodynamically across the region, ensuring each parcel's unique character is preserved through separate vinification. Under the guidance of Barossa icon, winemaker Damien Tscharke, Craneford continues to tell the story of the Barossa's finest terroirs through its commitment to quality and place-driven wines.

FLINT RIVER CLARE VALLEY, SA

Flint River Vineyards source their Riesling from Pauletts Polish Hill River vineyards, farmed sustainably with no use of synthetic herbicides and long term use of cover crops in the vineyards. The fruit is gently pressed, taking only the free run juice, which is wild fermented using natural yeast in stainless steel, and aged on fine lees for 3 months before being filtered and bottled young to capture the purity of Clare Valley Riesling.

TWIN VALLEYS KING VALLEY, VIC

Sourcing fruit from Victoria's twin valleys - the King and Alpine valleys, these wines explore the cool high-country climate with fresness and purity. The snow capped peaks that surround these valleys offer a reminder of the unique climatic offering and the suitability for growing varieties like Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Nebbiolo with character and tension. A gentle touch with the winemaking keeps these wines feeling modern and fresh.



ROBERT ALLAIT CHAMPAGNE, FR

(Villers-sous-Châtillon, Vallée de la Marne)
A family estate spanning nearly two centuries, now run by the fifth generation, Champagne
Robert Allait farms 14 hectares across six communes on the southern slopes of the Marne
Valley. Deeply devoted to Pinot Meunier, the house showcases its versatility through a terroir-driven range. Certified HVE3, the domaine embraces sustainable, biodiversity-focused viticulture, crafting wines of depth, supple fruit, and mineral finesse that express the limestone-rich soils of the Marne.

PATRICK BOIVIN CHAMPAGNE, FR

(Épernay, Vallée de la Marne)
Marie-Madeleine and Patrick Boivin founded this family-run house in Épernay, uniting generations of grower heritage from Cumières with a shared vision for artisanal
Champagne. Today, their daughters Baptistine and Céline continue the pursuit of authenticity and precision. The 6 hectares of vineyards—mostly in the Vallée de la
Marne—are cultivated under lutte raisonnée, emphasizing ecological balance. With Premier
Cru parcels in Pierry, Cumières, Vinay, Brugny-Vaudancourt, Damery, and Épernay, the wines capture the delicacy, depth, and vitality of the Marne.

DOMAINE LA MEULIÈRE CHABLIS, FR

(Fleys, Chablis)

Founded in 1780, this eighth- and ninth-generation family estate is guided by Vincent and Nicolas Laroche, who carry forward a legacy of precision and respect for terroir. Based in Fleys on the right bank of the Serein, La Meulière farms 30 hectares across 40 plots in Béru, Chablis, Chichée, Fontenay, and Fleys, all rooted in Kimmeridgian clay-limestone soils. Certified HVE3, the domaine's hand-pruned, hand-harvested vines produce wines of purity, mineral tension, and finely etched texture, true to Chablis' distinctive character.

DOMAINE LEMOULE BURGUNDY, FR

(Coulanges-la-Vineuse, Northern Burgundy)
Founded in 1950 by Jean Lemoule, the domaine is now run by his grandson Steve, alongside his father and siblings. The family farms some of the appellation's best lieu-dits under sustainable and organic practices. Situated just west of Chablis, Coulanges-la-Vineuse is one of Burgundy's northernmost red wine villages, its limestone-heavy soils yielding Pinot Noirs of freshness, finesse, and supple fruit. Steve's thoughtful winemaking emphasizes roundness and vibrancy, highlighting both the charm and exceptional value of the appellation.

CÉCILE PAQUET MACON, FR

(Senozan, Southern Burgundy)


A micro-domaine of 1.5 hectares, Cécile Paquet channels over two decades of plant cultivation expertise into her vines in Senozan. Working with meticulous care and deep respect for natural rhythms, she crafts wines that express purity and vitality. Certified organic (Ecocert) and practising biodynamic, the estate focuses on soil health and balance, producing precise, vibrant wines that reflect the quiet intensity of southern Burgundy's terroir.

CHÂTEAU LARONDE-DESORMES BORDEAUX, FR

(Macau-en-Médoc, Bordeaux)
Situated at the gateway to Margaux, Château
Laronde Desormes was founded in 1790 and
revitalized by the Tessandier family since 1992.
The 16-hectare estate sits on rare palus soils,
producing wines of finesse and roundness. Planted
at 6,500 vines/ha, the vineyard is composed of
70% Merlot and 30% Cabernet Sauvignon. The
château's ongoing transition to HVE3 certification
underscores its commitment to sustainability. Each
cuvée reflects a balance of tradition, terroir, and
innovation, offering supple textures and refined
structure.




CHÂTEAU HAUT-FERRAND BORDEAUX, FR

(Pomerol, Bordeaux)

Owned by the Gasparoux family since 1934, Château Ferrand is now managed by three generations who preserve and evolve the estate's legacy. Expanded in 1975 with Château Haut-Ferrand on the Pomerol plateau, the combined 15.5 hectares rest on sandy, gravelly soils laced with iron oxide, producing elegant, age-worthy wines. Certified HVE3 and ISO 14001, and now under organic conversion, the family blends heritage and modernity, crafting Pomerols of depth, precision, and timeless charm.

GIOVANNI ROSSO ETNA, IT

(Etna, Sicily)

A family-owned estate with roots in Serralunga d'Alba since the 1890s, Giovanni Rosso embodies the philosophy that "wine should be a perfect copy of its terroir." Under Davide Rosso's stewardship since 2001, the wines reflect the elegance and minerality of Barolo's limestone slopes. In 2016, the family expanded to Mount Etna, cultivating 6 hectares of Carricante and Nerello Mascalese near Solicchiata. Both estates are farmed organically, producing wines of clarity, energy, and volcanic precision, uniting Piedmont tradition with Sicilian vitality.

BRIC CENCIURIO BAROLO, IT

(Roero, Langhe & Barolo, Piedmont)
Founded in the early 1990s by Franco Pittatore and Carlo Sacchetto, Bric Cenciurio brings together family vineyards from Roero, Langhe, and Barolo.
Today, Alessandro and Alberto Pittatore, alongside their mother Fiorella and uncle Carlo, continue the vision with a deep respect for nature. The 16 hectares are farmed organically and sustainably, avoiding synthetic chemicals and preserving natural forest zones for biodiversity. Manual vineyard work and gentle cellar practices yield wines of authentic expression and precision, reflecting both heritage and thoughtful innovation.
