Bizzarro is made by taking super aromatic organic and biodynamic skin contact Vermentino from the Basham family in the heart of the Riverland and infusing it with traditional aperitivo ingredients such as rhubarb and gentian root providing bitterness. From here Greg has upped the ante, using organically grown Riverland oranges and lemons to create an intoxicating citrus hit. Finally he fortifies this blend adding neutral grape spirit which has been infused with a secret array of fruits, herbs and other botanicals. Bizzarro is a local aperitivo that perfectly balances sweet and bitter, making it incredibly versatile. Its less sweet than Aperol and less bitter than Campari giving endless options for your summer cocktail list. We recommend pouring it into pet nat for a delightful Spritz, or mixing it with local gin and vermouth for an all Aussie Negroni.

Domaine du Chétif Quart (NEW)

The Domaine du Chétif Quart is a family domain of six hectares in the Côte Chalonnaise region of Burgundy. The family home and winery are set on the slopes of Mont Avril, just south of the Givry appellation. Lucas D'Heilly Huberdeau took over his family's domain in 2019 and with the vintage 2021 changed the domain name from D'Heilly Huberdeau to Chétif Quart, reflecting the domain's "lieu dit". Lucas's parents, Pierre D'Heilly and Martine Huberdeau, both professors of Ecology at the Sorbonne in Paris, arrived in Burgundy in 1978 to, as they say, 'practice what they preached'. Establishing one of the earliest organic estates in Burgundy. Lucas's winemaking follows his parent's tradition - simple and classic and with *élevage* on lees in mostly neutral oak, often for up to 4 years for the sparkling, and gentle use of sulfur.




Lulu Vigneron - Ludwig Bindernagel

Matassa

Domaine Matassa was formed back in 02' when New Zealander Tom Lubbe purchased ancient, 100+ year old vines, on the remote hillside of Vivier in Roussillon. Stefano Occhetti

Roero DOCG is the third point of a triangle surrounding the town of Alba, the other two neighbours across the river being famously Barolo and Barbaresco. But Roero remains relatively unheralded due to its difficult terrain and small number of great growers, despite its potential for fresher, finer Nebbioli. Stefano Occhetti is one vigneron who returned to reclaim the greatness of his family's land in the 'Occhetti' cru of Roero in 2019 after an engineering career abroad. Few in his generation are interested in the challenge of Roero, one of the steepest and most rugged areas in Piedmont to work, so Stefano has spent the past few years scooping up prime historic vineyards, like the famous 'Sanche' cru, from retiring farmers. Thus a new star is born, with his dedication to excellence plain to see in the bottle.

In the pantheon of Piedmontese grapes, Dolcetto is known as the winemaker's drink. There's good reason for this, it's supple tannins, light frame and perfume are like Beaujolais when compared to the Cote d'Or. But there is a DOCG where Dolcetto reigns supreme and is elevated to another level: Dogliani, which neighbours the Barolo zone to its south. Here, most will tell you there is a rising star, a prodigy named Nicholas Altare. Who took over his 5th generation family estate at just 16, and despite a decade of work, he remains one of the youngest growers in the portfolio. Nicholas has worked on the side for the legendary Ferdinando Pricipiano for a long time and his sensitivity to nature and winemaking are akin to the greatest producers, yielding mineral, soft and complex Dolcetto from these limestone hills.

Cascina Val Liberata

Nestled in the wooded hills of Monferrato a short winding drive north from Asti, Dierdre O'Brien and Maurizio Caffer have created a small paradise that seems a million miles from the bustle of the Piedmontese wine trade. They planted their 3.5 hectares of vines 10 years ago on these steep limestone hillsides surrounded by nature; Nebbiolo, Grignolino of course and a rare almost extinct local variety called Slarina, which gives a light delicate wine of great beauty. Their work is all according to the moon, they use biodynamics and manage all the vineyard work themselves. These are fresh, beautiful examples of the wines of Monferrato, a very underrated corner of this great region.

Giulietta (NEW)

Alessandro Aldegheri is a young grower from Colognola ai Colli, in the foothills of Soave outside Verona. He's the third generation of vine-growers here, he studied agriculture and remains deeply attached to the teachings of his grandfather, which led him to create his winery Aretè. Alessandro farms 6ha of vineyards inherited from his family, from which he make the Giulietta Soave DOC exclusively for Lo-Fi. The wine is 80% Garganega, the historic white grape of Soave, with 20% Trebbiano di Soave. The soils express the dual character of the region: limestone in Colognola ai Colli for the Garganega and volcanic soil in Roncà for the Trebbiano. This classic northern Italian white is fermented with indigenous yeasts, and aged in stainless capturing the freshness of the region.

Colombaia

The Colombaia farm in Colle Val d'Elsa in the hamlet of Mensanello, has been in Dante Lomazzi's family for several generations. Planted in 1970 and converted to certified biodynamics in 2003, the idea was to treat this very special 4ha plot like a big garden, with fruit trees, vegetable gardens and flowers surrounding the vines. The now 40 year old vineyards are planted to Tuscany's native grapes of Sangiovese, Colorino, Malvasia Nera and Canaiolo. They have a simple cellar, set up to use the flow of gravity and to not need mechanical pumps. Wines are aged in Slavonian oak for extended periods of time and many cuvees have several bottling dates. The wines from Colombaia age beautifully and reflect the very special farm they are from.

Collecapretta

Since the 1100s, the Mattioli family has lived in the tiny settlement the Romans dubbed Collecapretta or “hill of the goats”. For generations, the Mattioli family have cultivated the rugged hillsides of this Umbrian village located just outside of Spoleto. Today, the farm is barely 8 hectares in total but boasts a dynamic mix of local olives trees, farro and other ancient grain plantings and about four hectare of indigenous old vines. The total production of Collecapretta is only about 8000 bottles during a good year, yet the family vinifies many different cuvées to show the various expressions their land is capable of.

L'Archetipo (NEW)

L'Archetipo stands at the foot of the Murgia Barese, a 'tufo' limestone plateau inland from the Ionian sea near Taranto. It was founded by Francesco Dibenedetto, a farmer from birth, who began converting the family farm to organics in the 80s, then biodynamics in 2000. After a few years, he realized that something was still preventing a return to the archetypal state of the soil. Inspired by the non-interventionist practices of Fukuoka, which foster synergies between all parts of the ecosystem, he moved to a synergistic agriculture, which, among other things, eliminates plowing. Joined now by his wife Anna Maria and their four children they vinify their 30Ha of native varieties with indigenous yeasts and without filtration in their cellar made entirely from local tufo stone.

Odinstal

Odinstal is the Pfalz outlier, a leading biodynamic winery and grand cru monopole, all nestled in a raised valley that lies on the edge of an extinct volcano. A few kilometers west of Wachenheim, Odinstal's terraced vineyards are found at the end of a dirt road that climbs 350 meters above sea level to a 19th century manor house and cellar. Since, 1998 Thomas and Ute Hensel have been the custodians of this precious site. The soils here are unique – quite different from the rest of the Pfalz with plots of nearly pure composition: basalt (basalt), sandstone (buntsandstein), shell limestone (muschelkalk), and keuper (keuper, a special kind of prehistoric-limestone). In 2004, Thomas brought on Andreas Schumann, the area's leading biodynamic practitioner to convert the vineyards and they have been certified for almost 20 years.
