Shipping

Bizzarro Bitter Aperitivo

Bizzarro Aperitivo is the newest addition to the Delinquent Wine Co family. It's a take on an all natural, Australian bitter aperitivo, made in the classic Delinquent way with scant regard for tradition, respect for nature and a product all about deliciousness. Bizzarro is made by taking super aromatic organic and biodynamic skin contact Vermentino from the Basham family in the heart of the Riverland and infusing it with traditional aperitivo ingredients such as rhubarb and gentian root providing bitterness. From here Greg has upped the ante, using organically grown Riverland oranges and lemons to create an intoxicating citrus hit. Finally he fortifies this blend adding neutral grape spirit which has been infused with a secret array of fruits, herbs and other botanicals. In 2017 Naïma and David Didon took over an old farm in Chassey-le-Camp in Côte Chalonnaise to realise their long held dream of their own biodynamic property. David, a seasoned viticulturist spent over a decade consulting with Etienne de Montille in Volnay as well as time in the cellar and fields with friends Julien Altaber and Dominique Derain. The estate follows a non-interventionist approach to winemaking, emphasizing the connection between terroir and vineyard. In terms of viticulture, the Savigny and 50% of the Bourgogne Hautes Côtes de Beaune are from Bastien's own vineyards, which have been certified organic since 2017. The other grapes come from trusted viticulturists (mostly friends of Bastien), practicing organic or similar methods. His winemaking philosophy involves simple vinifications, short macerations, and aging in high quality oak, with not more than 30% new. His focus is on fruit purity and freshness, a hallmark of the younger generation of Burgundian stars.

Jerome Balmet

Jérôme Balmet learned his craft working with both Jean-Claude Lapalu and Mathieu Lapierre and produced his first vintage in 2012. He has just 3.5ha of vines split between Vaux-en-beaujolais and Saint-Etienne-des-Oullières just south of Brouilly. His site in Vaux consists of 50-year-old vines planted on blue granite on a steep hillside vineyard, while his Saint-Etienne-des-Oullières site is heavier soil down on the valley floor producing wines of greater density. Nestled in the wooded hills of Monferrato a short winding drive north from Asti, Dierdre O'Brien and Maurizio Caffer have created a small paradise that seems a million miles from the bustle of the Piedmontese wine trade. They planted their 3.5 hectares of vines 10 years ago on these steep limestone hillsides surrounded by nature; Nebbiolo, Grignolino of course and a rare almost extinct local variety called Slarina, which gives a light delicate wine of great beauty. High in the hills above Vittorio Veneto, in San Lorenzo, Alberto and Marta run 4.5 hectares of vines. Colombaia

The Colombaia farm in Colle Val d'Elsa in the hamlet of Mensanello, has been in Dante Lomazzi's family for several generations. Planted in 1970 and converted to certified biodynamics in 2003, the idea was to treat this very special 4ha plot like a big garden, with fruit trees, vegetable gardens and flowers surrounding the vines. The soils here are unique – quite different from the rest of the Pfalz with plots of nearly pure composition: basalt (basalt), sandstone (buntsandstein), shell limestone (muschelkalk), and keuper (keuper, a special kind of prehistoric-limestone). In 2004, Thomas brought on Andreas Schumann, the area's leading biodynamic practitioner to convert the vineyards and they have been certified for almost 20 years.

Max Sein Wein was founded in 2016 by Max Baumann who after several years honing his craft at Judith Beck and most formatively with Gut Oggau in Austria returned to his family winery in Dertingen (Baden) to start making his own wines just the way he wanted to. He took over 3.5 ha which he farms himself Biodynamically. In the cellar max is completely hands off with all wines remaining sulphur free and yet remarkably stable. Max gives his wines around 9-10 months in wood and around 6 months in the bottle before release. He likes to play with different techniques, part carbonic maceration, part skin macerated and part direct pressed. His whites are textural, his rose electric and his red bright and full of joy. These are wines for the natural and classic, fine, elegant and a joy to enjoy over several days.
